With reference to the unauthorized occupation by Mr.O'Leary of portions of the Indian Reserve at Restigouche, P.Q., in connection with his saw mill and for piling timber, I have to request that you will report to the Department what area of land is occupied by Mr.O'Leary for the above purposes. If you are unable to make the measurements yourself, you may employ a surveyor to do so, if there is one resident in the locality.
