Following is situation from bases of information available up to 1730 6th June.

- (1) Situation regarding beaches, East to West.
 - (a) 3 enemy coastal batteries between S Beach and mouth of Seine not silenced. Heavy bombers called for.
 - (b) S beach clearance of beach going well at 0857.
 - (c) Juno Beach. Beachhead objectives in hand by 1100. Leading forces half way to immediate divisional objective and reserve brigade being sent in. Several major landing craft damaged by teller mines.
 - (d) Gold beach all self-propelled artillery landed, and beach exits established by 1043. No air opposition. Situation generally good.
