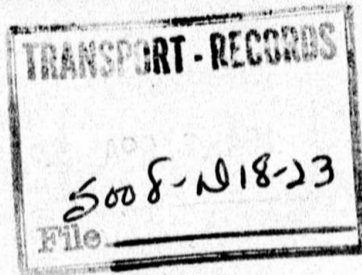

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1. Mr. C. M. Marshall of Marshalls Flying Service has advised that this aircraft has been scrapped and parts sold for ultra light aircraft. Mr. Fred Gillies of Gillies Flying Service advises that the Certificates of Registration and Airworthiness were returned to the Department the year of Hurricane Hazel, in which the aircraft was destroyed. There is no record on file in this office of the certificates ever having been received and they are presumed lost.
