- I
Superficial deposits
Sand, gravel, etc. clay, and much volcanic material of various kinds and volcanic material.
- II
Basaltic andesite porphyry and related volcanic with their associated tuffs and breccias
- III
Basaltic andesite and related volcanic with their associated tuffs and breccias
- IV
Coast Range intrusives
Granite and a variety of granitic and granitic to dioritic with associated porphyry phases.
- V
Andesite basalt and diabase with their associated tuffs and breccias
- VI
Tantalus conglomerate
Calcareous, with some sandstone, shale and siltstone of coal.
- VII
Laberge series
Argillite, shale, sandstone, siltstone, greywacke, conglomerate and tuff.
- VIII
Limestone, quartz or less dolomite
- IX
Peculiar and primitive
- X
Mount Stevens group
Schist, gneiss, quartzite, and limestone.
