own homes, the gospel-hardened in our own land, and the morally degraded among the heathen, says to you and to me: "Love them as I have loved you." Thus He speaks to every one of us here to-night, and we will each have something to say to Him. What shall it be? "The love of Christ constraineth me, because I thus judge that if one died for all, then were all dead, and that He died for all that they who live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto Him who died for them and rose again."

There is no life worth living but that of devotion to Him, and to the furtherance of His kingdom. Let me seek to have the centre of my life shifted off self on to Him. Let me plan and give, and work and pray, assured of His presence, depending on His help, and confidently expecting the fulfilment of His promise.
