MEMORANDUM

The following information was obtained from the records of the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce, for the year 1907. It shows that the total population of the United States was 92,228,496, an increase of 1,100,000 over the population of 1906. The increase was due to a surplus of 1,100,000 births over deaths during the year.
