XV. And he is further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that if any goods, wares or merchandifes on which Duties are payable by this Act, and which shall be imported into this Province after the paifing thereof, thati receive any damage by falt, water or otherwise during the course of the voyage after such goods, water or merchandises shall have been laden or shipped in foreign parts, and before the same shall be unshipped or diichar jed from the ibip or vellel in which they shall be imported into this Province, fo that the owner or owners thereof shall be prejudiced in the fale of such goods, wares or nurchandiles: the two principal Officers of the cultoms at the place where the fame-fault he landed, if there are two, otherwise the principal Officer shall have power to choose three indifferent merchants experienced in the value of such goods, wares and merch indifes, who or any two of whom upon viewing the fame, shall certify and declare upon their corporal octas, first administered by the said Oslicers, or one of them, who is and are hereby antherifed and empowered to administer the same, what damage fuch goods, wares or merchandiles have received, and how much the fame are leffened in their true value by fach damage, in relation to the Duties imposed on them by this Act, and thereupon the principal Glicers of his Majesty's customs at -Quebec, whereof the Collector for the time being thall be one, shall and they are hereby , authorifed and required to make a proportionable allowance to the merchant by way of return or repayment out of the Duties due or which shall have been actually paid for the fame.

The Collection on make up his accounts.

NVI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that an account of all the monies which shall arise by the aforesaid Rates and Duties, shall be made up quarterly by the Coilector of the cultoms and comptrolled by the Comptroller thereof, and shaned by both of them, and fworn to by the Collector, before the Covernor. Lieute-. nant Governor or Person administering the government, and to him delivered and all fuch monies thall be paid at the end of every quarter into the hands of his Majesty's Receiver General of this Province, without deduction, excepting only fuch fum or fums as firali have been paid by the Collector for the drawback on falt and the allowances on the exportation of falted beef, pork and filh, and excepting also such sum or fums of money as shall have been by him repaid or returned for Daties on goods, wares or merchandiles which shall have been loit, destroyed or damaged before the fame were landed; and also such sum or sums of money as shall have been paid for allowance or abatement of Duty on tobacco manufactured in this Province, as herein before directed; and there shall also be made up quarterly an account of the incidents incurred, and the fame finall be figured by the Collector and Comptroller, and fworn to by the faid Collector in manner before directed, which account shall also be delivered to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the government, and being by him approved in his Majesty's Executive Council, a warrant shall iffue directed to the Receiver General for the payment thereof to the faid Collector.

Exception.

All Dusies imposed by this Act made payable to his Majerty.

XVII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that out of the monies which shall arise by the Rates and Duties, granted by this Ast, and by the Duties granted by an Ast pasted in this Session of the Legislature, intituled, "An Ast for granting to his, Majesty Duties on licences to Hawkers, Pedlars and Petty chapmen, and for regulating their trade; and for granting additional Duties on licences to persons for keeping houses of public entertainment or for the retailing wine, brandy, rum or any other spirituous liquers in this Province, and for regulating the sand for repealing the Ast or Ordinance therein mentioned," and further which shall arise by such part or parts of the penalties and forfeitures incurred under all or either of the said Asts, as by all or either of them, is or are directed to be paid to and for the use of his Majesty, his heirs and successors, there shall be issued and paid the sum of two hundred and eleven pounds, sisteen ships
