

shall, if brought therefrom to any other part of this Province, be dealt with as if imported from a place beyond the limits of the Province; and it shall be lawful, notwithstanding anything in the said Act to the contrary, for the Governor in Council to issue his Proclamation declaring the said Free Ports to be closed from and after the Fifteenth day of September next.

Ordered, That the said Resolutions be now read a second time;

And the first to the sixth Resolutions, inclusive, being read a second time, were agreed to.

The seventh Resolution, being read a second time, and the Question being put, That this House doth concur with the Committee in the said Resolution, the House divided: and it was Resolved in the Affirmative.

The eighth Resolution, being read a second time, was agreed to.

The ninth Resolution being read a second time, and the Question being put, That this House doth concur with the Committee in the said Resolution; the House divided: and it was Resolved in the Affirmative.

The tenth Resolution, being read a second time, and the Question proposed, That this House doth concur with the Committee in the said Resolution;

Mr. McGill moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. Gibbs, That all the words after "That" to the end of the Question be left out, and the words "The tenth Resolution, in so far as it exempts Factory Machinery of all kinds from duty, be not now concurred in, but that it be re-committed to a Committee of the whole House, with instructions to place such machinery in the 15 per cent. list," inserted instead thereof.
