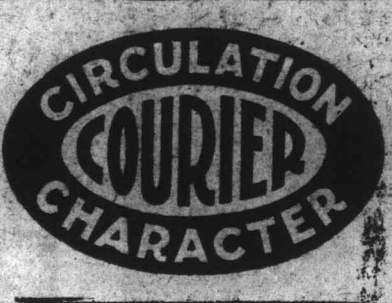

Havana, Nov. 11.—A general strike in support of the demands of the Federated Harbor Unions has been called by a committee representing every union in the city. Members of harbor unions quit work more than a week ago and a number of their leaders were arrested on charges of coercion and sentenced to serve eighty days in prison. It was in support of the demand of the liberation of these men that the general strike was called.
