SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

THE sole need of a family or any man over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District.

SYNOPSIS OF COAL MINING REGULATIONS.

COAL MINING RIGHTS of the Dominion of Alberta, the Yukon Territory, the Northwest Territories and in a portion of the Province of British Columbia, may be leased for a term of twenty-one years at an annual rental of \$1 an acre.
