Severe Squall in Some Parts of Canada.

Tornadoes in Illinois and Other

States.

TORONTO AND VICINITY.

About [3.15 Mo day afternoon, a storm obe over this city which presented a reatening aspect for about five or six nutes. A gale preceded rain, which a succeeded by a shower of hall stones, was succeeded by a shower of hall stones, which broke several windows in the schools and other large buildings. Otherwise, no serious damage was reported. A small schooner lost some canvas as she entered the harbour. The staysail was blown clean away and the foresail badly split. A report from Richmond Hill, sixteen miles north of the city, states that a barn belonging to Mr. Wm. Calvert, 4th con. of Markham, was struck by lightning and, with its contents, completely destroyed. There was an insurance of \$500 on the building, but nothing on the contents. but nothing on the contents.

OAKVILLE, April 26.—During the heavy squall which suddenly struck this place this afternoon, a young man named James Pickett, about eighteen years of age, of Bronte, lost his life. It appears he was raking stone in a scow near the shore at Bronte when the squall struck him, and, thinking to save himself from being blown out into the lake, he jumped overboard, and attempted to swim ashore with the aid of a plank, but failed in the attempte and was drowned before help could reach him. His body has not yet been recovered, although parties are raking for it, Great damage has been done all over the country. Although the storm only lasted a few minutes houses were unroofed, barns destroyed, and trees blown down, and in one case a lady and gentleman lifted out of their buggy and deposited in the road. Fences are blown down, and the roads are blocked up in a great many places. No damage to ship-ELSEWHERE IN CANADA. blown down, and the reacs are blocked up in a great many places. No damage to shipping has been reported as yet. The storm commenced with a violent wind, followed by a heavy fall of rain, which lasted twenty minutes.

Berlin, Out., April 26.—A very violent

storm, accompanied by hail, passed over this place at two o'clock this afternoon, Considerable damage was done to the Lutheran church, which was unroofed and the gable end blown in, completely

and the gable end blown in, completely destroying the ceiling, pews and floor. Quite a number of other outbuildings were either unroofed or blown over. The storm lested less than ten minutes.

Guelen, April 26,—A heavy wind atorm, accompanied by thunder and lightning passed over this neighbourhood this afternoon. A barn in course of erection on the farm of Mr. John Murphy, Mount Tars, was blown down. Mr. Murphy, who was on the building, had not time to get down owing to the suddenness of the storm, and was precipitated to the ground with it. He was picked up insensible. Ais injuries are severe but not considered dangerous, Another barn in the vicinity had the roof completely lifted off, UNITED STATES. TANLORVILLE, Ill., April 26.—Christian County was ravaged on Saturday night by an awful cyclone, coming like a funnel-shaped cloud, with the point downward, with a roar like a mighty cataract. It was only of a few minutes' duration, and was followed by a dead calm. The course marked a space of thirty rods wide, and ten miles long. The destruction of life and property was terrible. Two powder cans in the store ignited in some way and exploded, injuring Valentine badly and fatally injuring the clerk. Nothing was left of many houses but the foundations. Mrs. Abner Hayne's was blown 200 yards and instantly killed. In nearly every house the inmates were injured. Not less than \$100,000 worth of property was destroyed within a district three miles long and half a mile wide.

Chroaco, April 26.—At Farmer City, Illinois, the creeks are higher than ever known before. Fences and bridges were carried off. Chas. Strausberg was drowned while trying to cross the creek on horse-At Kankakee an almost unprece-

while trying to cross the creek on horse-back. At Kankakee an almost unprece-dented amount of water fell. The river rose five feet. Farm lands were flooded and work delayed two weeks. Much of the lately sown grain was drowned out. MERIDAN, Mass., April 26.— Heavy storms passed over Macon, Miss., last night, blowing away twenty-two houses, including the M. & O. R. machine shops, round-house, depot, telegraph office, and the master mechanic's office. Sixteen cars were blown from the track.
