do for his cows. In these cases, is the fault of the cows—they have not the power within themselves of making milk from their feed. They seem to change their feed into blood which is used as a basis for manufacturing beef, instead of milk. In addition, there are cows which ap-

addition, there are cows which apparently do little or nothing with their feed—they neither give milk in paying quantity, nor do they become fat. These are classed as "boarder" cows, and are very unprofitable for a farmer to keep.

The only way to know for certain whether or, not a cow is able to secrete milk in paying quantity, is to weigh the milk from each cow for at least three days in each month. Also test the milk for fat at least twice during each lactation period. twice during each lactation period. In this way, the owner may select the good from the poor cows, and thus build up a profitable herd for dairy purposes. — Prof. H. H. Dean, Ontario purposes.—Prof. H. H.
