McCook, of Trinity College, contributes the second of his articles on "Practical Politics: What Can Clergymen do About It?" D. S. Schaff, D.D., writes instructively on "The Graves of Egypt." "Immortality in the Light of History and Reason," is the theme of an interesting paper by Rev. W. H. Hsley. A concluding article on "The Higher Criticism," by Rev. J. Westby Earnshaw, states and answers some of the objections to that much discussed mode of treating the Sacred Scriptures. Wm. Hayce Ward, D.D., writes upon "The Immortality of the Soul in the Inscription of Panamunui." The Sermonic Section is more than usually rich in its material. The Exegetical Section has a suggestive treatment of Heb. ii. 5-9, by Prof. Wm. Milligan, D.D., of Aberdeen, one of the ablest living exegetes. Rev. J. Winthrop Hegeman, Ph. D., contributes another sociological study of London, discussing the work respectively of the Church Army and the Salvation Army. The remaining sections have their usual interest.
