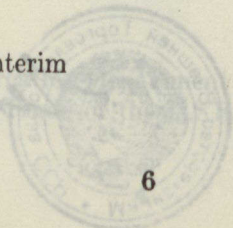

Agreement reached between us. The agreement reached between us is that the U.S.S.R. will pay to Canada the amount of 1,000,000 Canadian dollars for supplies delivered by Canada in 1949. The payment will be made in three installments of 333,333 Canadian dollars each, on the following dates: 30 September 1950, 30 November 1950, and 30 January 1951. The first installment of 333,333 Canadian dollars has been paid to Canada on 30 September 1950. The second installment of 333,333 Canadian dollars will be paid to Canada on 30 November 1950. The third installment of 333,333 Canadian dollars will be paid to Canada on 30 January 1951. The total amount of 1,000,000 Canadian dollars will be paid to Canada by the U.S.S.R. for supplies delivered by Canada in 1949.

Accept, Mr. Plenipotentiary, the assurance of my highest respect to you.
