What is an URL?



A Uniform Resource Locator, commonly referred to as an URL, is the unique address of each page of information on the World Wide Web. It can be found in the Location field of Netscape. These URLs can be quite lengthy or very short.

How do I create a bookmark?




You must be at the site you wish to bookmark, then:

- Click Bookmarks from the Netscape Main menu
- Select Add Bookmark

Your Bookmark is added at the bottom of the list under View Bookmarks. The title of the page becomes the title of your bookmark.
