Example VII

This example portrays Canadian (Header 1) data for one year, 1978, (Header 2), for total imports and for imports for all one digit levels of the Standard International Trade Classification System (printed across the top of the page).

Canada's top seven major suppliers are ranked in descending order of importance and are printed across the page, under the appropriate SITC description column. In this example, two options were selected.

Options

First Percentage Line - Percent SITC Total

In the year 1978, Canada imported \$1,557,196,000 US of SITC commodity - "Crude Materials, Inedible, Except Fuels", from the U.S.A. This amount accounted for 4.45% of Canada's total imports of \$34,980,256,000 US from the U.S.A. and ranked the U.S.A. as the top supplier of Canadian imports of "Crude Materials, Inedible, Except Fuels".
