The Department of External Affairs announced that Mr. Raoul Bibica Rosetti presented today to the Deputy Governor, Hon. Mr. Justice P. Kerwin, at the Supreme Court of Canada Building his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Greece to Canada.

The Acting Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, Mr. Escott Reid, was present. Mr. P. Reading of the Protocol Division presented Mr. Rosetti to the Deputy Governor General. The Ambassador was accompanied by Mr. John C. Cambiotis, First Secretary of the Embassy.

Mr. Rosetti was born in Athens in 1693. He studied at the University of Athens, from which he obtained the degree of D.C.L. in 1913. He entered the Greek diplomatic service in 1914, and has served at Berne, Cairo, Sofia, Berlin, Geneva and Belgrade. From 1932 to 1934 he was Head of the Political Department of the Foreign Office at Athens. He was Private Secretary to His late Majesty King George II of Greece during his exile in London from 1944 to 1946, and accompanied him on his return to Greece. Prior to his appointment to Canada, Mr. Rosetti was Minister of Greece to the Union of South Africa.
