THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT DR.

LUTHER EVANS, DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL,

SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION, WILL VISIT OTTAWA

OCTOBER 14 TO 16, 1956. HE WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY MR. RENE

MAHEU, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR GENERAL AND PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE

OF UNESCO AT THE UNITED NATIONS HEADQUARTERS, NEW YORK.

WHILE IN OTTAVA DR. EVANS WILL CALL ON THE PRIME MINISTER,
THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CANADIAN BROARDCASTING CORPORATION, THE
DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL GALLERY, THE GOVERNMENT FILM COMMISSIONER
AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL RESEARCH COUNCIL. HE WILL ALSO HAVE
DISCUSSIONS WITH MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE MINITH
SESSION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF UNESCO, WHICH OPENS IN
NEW DELHI, INDIA, NOVEMBER 5 (PRESS RELEASE NO. 56 OF SEPTEMBER
14, 1956), AND WITH OFFICIALS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL
AFFAIRS.

ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 15, HE WILL ADDRESS A PUBLIC LUNCHEON IN HIS MONOUR AT THE CHATEAU LAURIER. THE LUNCHEON IS BEING SPONSORED BY THE UNITED NATIONS ASSOCIATION IN CANADA, WITH THE COOPERATION OF THE CANADIAN TEACHERS' FEDERATION, THE CANADA FOUNDATION, THE CANADIAN SOCIAL SCIENCE RESEARCH COUNCIL, THE CHEMICAL INSTITUTE OF CANADA, THE CANADIAN LIBRARY ASSOCIATION AND THE OTTAWA BRANCH OF THE UNITED NATIONS ASSOCIATION. THE SUBJECT OF HIS ADDRESS WILL BE "THE TASKS OF THE NEXT TEN YEARS".

DR. EVANS WILL BE THE GUEST AT A GOVERNMENT LUNCHEON AT THE COUNTRY CLUB ON THESDAY, OCTOBER 16. THE HOST WILL BE MR. LUCIEN CARDIN, M.P., PARLIAMENTARY ASSISTANT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS.
