

APPENDIX

Services to be provided under the Memorandum of Understanding between Canada and Australia:

- (a) intervention in the case of arrest or detention;
- (b) relief, financial assistance and repatriation (services provided on a recoverable basis), including intervention in the case of deportation;
- (c) assistance in the case of illness and hospitalization, including arrangements for the payment of medical and hospital accounts (services provided on a recoverable basis);
- (d) issue of emergency travel documents (limited in time and for specified purposes);
- (e) assistance with arrangements regarding the deaths of citizens including local burial or shipment of the remains;
- (f) assistance relating to lost or stolen property enquiries;
- (g) assistance relating to local enquiries regarding the whereabouts of nationals of the other country;
- (h) assistance relating to the emergency evacuation of nationals;
- (i) local registration of nationals;
- (j) retention of private mail on behalf of travelling citizens, if the responsible mission already does this for its own citizens.
