The following answer, deposited with the Clerk of the house, is printed in the official report of debates pursuant to standing order 39:

DRILL HALL CONTRACT, DRUMMONDVILLE, QUE.

Question No. 421—Mr. Dufresne:

1. Who was awarded the contract for the construction of the drill hall at Drummondville, Quebec, and at what price?
2. What are the names of those who tendered and what was the amount of each tender?
3. How much did the drill hall cost when completed?

Answer by: Mr. Dickey, Parliamentary Assistant, for the Minister of Defence Production:

1. John F. Wickenden Company, Limited, Three Rivers, Quebec, in the amount of \$265,600, plus the assignment of the contract for the structural steel in the amount of \$18,654, a total of \$284,254.
