

I have 20 names of petitioners from the Burlington area, Orangeville, Scarborough, Toronto and Beeton. These petitioners must have signed at their place of work, because they come from an area surrounding Toronto.

I have names of many petitioners from the Milton, Mississauga, Georgetown and Orangeville area, totalling some 146 names.

I have another petition signed by people from Milton and Acton, which is a nice place to visit. It is just north of Milton. These are all delightful parts of Ontario. It is interesting to see the number of people who have signed these petitions and how they are concerned about what is happening with respect to the GST.

I have another 27 names of people, at least 20 of whom are from the Brampton and Mississauga area, as well as someone from Nepean and Milton.

These 27 petitioners come from the Campbellville area, which is not far from Milton. It is the home of the Mohawk racetrack, for anyone who is interested in harness racing. Rockwood is a lovely village in that same area.

This group of petitioners comes from north of Toronto, right up Yonge Street, as it were. There are 16 names of people from Newmarket on here. The petition also includes people from Willowdale and Beamsville.

I have a list of 27 petitioners from the Brampton, Mississauga and Georgetown area.

I have well over 100 signatures of people from east of Toronto, including Oshawa, Newmarket, Baysville, Don Mills, Rice Lake and other areas in the lake country where people are equally concerned about the possible effects of GST on them.

I have the names of another 20 petitioners from Huntsville and Baysville.

On this petition I must have the signatures of well over 200 people from the Baysville area alone.

We have a great number from the Richmond Hill area again, from Baysville and Toronto, Burlington, Weston, and Lake of Bays. I have a name from Florida, which we will have to ignore. Of the 20, I count only 19.

Here is another group from the Baysville area. I do not know what is happening in that area, but they certainly are very exercised about the GST. These are petitioners from Huntsville and Toronto, Barrie, more from Baysville, and Brampton. Members of Parliament who come from that area

must be getting all sorts of petitions themselves, asking them to do something about changing the government's mind on the GST.

Here we have 20 more names from Baysville, Scarborough, Niagara Falls, Willowdale, Rockwood, all of which are in Ontario, and from Saint Laurent, Quebec.

There are 20 more, again from Baysville, Toronto, Huntsville, St. Catharines, Willowdale and Scarborough, Thornhill and Etobicoke.

Then we have a further 19 from Baysville, Bracebridge, Rexdale, Toronto, Etobicoke, Burlington.

I think I underestimated the number of people in the Baysville area, because here is another petition with 20 names, half of whom appear to be from that area. We also have petitioners from Richmond Hill, Etobicoke, Toronto, and Notre Dame de Grace, Quebec.

We have a group of 17 names from the Barrie area, Fergus, Huntsville, Burlington, Hamilton, and Dorset.

There are 16 names from Bala, Rosseau, Huntsville. This is beautiful lake country in Ontario. A great place to live.

Again, we have names from Baysville, Weston, Dorset, Toronto, and Mississauga.

There are another 20 names from Baysville, Bracebridge, Newmarket, Toronto, and Bowmanville.

There are 20 more, mostly from the Mississauga area. I see one signature from the Bridle Path in Toronto, which is rather interesting. That is a very wealthy area of the city, but even there the people are concerned about the effects of the GST.

Here are 20 names, mostly from the Toronto area; but I see Etobicoke, Baysville again, and Buffalo, New York. I do not know how he got in there. Perhaps he is one of the people who have just moved down there as a result of our problems. Finally, we have Niagara-on-the-Lake, a lovely spot.

Here are 20 names from Baysville, Toronto, and Barrie.

Here is another 20, starting off again with Baysville. Then we have Peterborough, Brampton, Mississauga, Toronto and Burlington.

There are another 20 from Etobicoke, Newmarket, Bradford, St. Catharines, Willowdale, Fonthill, Downsview, Strathroy, Richmond Hill, Baysville, and Bradford, all on the one petition.

We have one with 14 names, of whom about 10 are from Baysville. Then we have Bracebridge.

We have another one from Baysville, St. Catharines and Dorset.

Here is another with 21 names, with about a dozen from Baysville. I have to go there sometime. I am not quite sure where it is, but it seems to be growing. I believe it is in the lake country.
