REPORT on TRIP to ATTEND MEETINGS of THE ASSOCIATION of AMERICAN MEDICAL COLLEGES, OMAHA, and the COUNCIL of MEDICAL EDUCATION, CHICAGO. and re Reorganization at Mulsile These Meetings were for the purpose of discussing Medical Education in general, the medical curriculum in particular, the relations of Medical Schools and Hospitals, Hospital Administration, and kindred subjects. At the Meeting of the Association of American Medical Colleges, every large School in the United States was represented. (There are 70 Class A. Medical Schools in the United States). Among the attendants at these Meetings were the Presidents of a number of the Universities, the Deans of all Medical Schools, some of the more prominent educationalists, and many other Professors and Heads of Departments. This Report embodies merely a summary of some of the more important features which concern our immediate problems, and the conclusions arrived at from listening to contributions given at the meetings and to private conversations with many of the more prominent educationalists.
