


## POSTSCRIPT.

Memoirs of the Administration of Sir FRANCIS N. BURTON, will also shortly be published, as well as the continuation of that of Lord DALHOUSIE, after his Lordship's return from England in 1825, until his departure from the Province in September, 1828.

The following is a Statement of the nett Revenue collected in Lower Canada, (the fifth, belonging to Upper Canada, deducted) from the years 1819 to 1824, inclusively—vizt :
