"Perfect the overhead delivery," probably will be able to pull more out of you than you think you can. The delivery that some pitchers use—but you can't be sure of control in that way—is called a "knuckleball." It's thrown rather freely at first when using the overhead throw. Keep at it. In time you'll learn to throw such fine control through the use of the wrist. You can place the ball where you want to—and that's the thing.

"Use the arm studying the ball," says Aler. Always memorize what kind of ball that fellow couldn't hit the first time he threw. Then, if you see him throw the same kind. "If he did hit the first time up, don't give him the same kind. If he didn't hit the first time, something else."
