**NOTICE TO SOLDIERS ON HARVEST LEAVE.**

Attention is directed to a recent announcement published in the Press by the Military Service Branch, Department of Justice, regarding extensions to be granted to men EXEMPTED AS FARMERS.

It is pointed out that this DOES NOT IN ANY WAY AFFECT MEN WHO HAVE BEEN ORDERED BY THE REGISTRAR TO REPORT TO DEPOT BATTALIONS and who have thereafter received leave of absence from the Military Authorities.

Once a man has been ordered to report for duty by the Registrar he leaves the jurisdiction of the Registrar and comes under that of the Department of Militia and Defence, and is to be considered as a soldier. This applies to men of the 20 to 22 Class who have been ordered to report by the Registrar in virtue of the cancellation of exemptions by Order-in-Council of the 20th April last, as well as to those ordered to report in the usual way on refusal of claim for exemption, or on expiration of exemption granted.

All men, accordingly, who have been ordered to report, and are therefore SOLDIERS, and who have subsequently been granted harvest leave by the military authorities, MUST, NOTWITHSTANDING THE NOTICE ABOVE REFERRED TO, REPORT ON THE EXPIRATION OF THAT LEAVE, unless they are notified to the contrary by their Commanding Officer or by general notice published by the Department of Militia and Defence.

**LIVE STOCK MARKET**

With a light run of cattle at the head in all, and a fairly good demand, the alleys were pretty well cleaned up by noon, and the odds and ends which always accumulate by Thursday were bought up at the market.

There was little or no change in the prices, practically all grades holding steady at Wednesday's prices. There were no extra choice cattle on the market, and anything in the line of good butchers found ready sale. It is questionable if there has been a load of real good steers on the market all week, out of the heavy consignments of western cattle received by one or two of the big plants. The market for next week is generally regarded as being likely to show heavy shipments, with steady prices.

The stocker and feeder trade is steady to strong, that is, in comparison with last week. There is a better demand for the good weighty class showing quality and breeding, and there were more class cattle.

There is not much change in the milkers and springers, but the general opinion

of the commission men is that the trade taken all round is better for this class, and they are wanted.

There are all sorts of rumors as to the prices being quoted, but the facts are substantially as stated. 17½c to 18c fed and watered, 18½c weighed off and 16½c to 17c f.o.b.

The run of lambs and sheep was 1550 the lambs selling a trifle stronger for the bulk or for the offerings, but some better prices were paid. The sheep trade was steady, and the market for the heavy ones, as the World again points out, are a decided drag on the market. They are not wanted, as the wide margin in the prices quoted plainly indicates.
