With things in this shape, practical stagnation on the Toronto Exchange causes no concern among traders, who are uncommitted and prepared to abide the time when profitable turns in either direction can be made by the forced changes in quotations. The dealings in domestic stocks to-day were as insignificant as the tendency to values. In the three more active speculative issues the undertone, if anything, was easier. The market, even in these, is too narrow to admit of quick turns, as the bid and asked prices easily testify. 
