NOISELESS GUN LATEST WEAPON

Hull Chemist Invents Remarkable Machine Which Discharges Explosive Gases.

SUCCESSFUL TRIALS

New Invention Which Ignites Everything it Hits at a Distance of Five Miles.

LONDON. March 15.—A remarkable machine gun has been invented by Mr. Ernest Welsh, a Hull chemist. The gun, weighing about three hundredweight, is discharged by explosive gases, and it is claimed that it will send projectiles a distance of five miles, which will then ignite-whatever they hit. The gun is not unlike a Maxim in appearance, and the mechanism consists in part of three generators which manufacture three distinct gases. In the stopper there is a small sponge saturated with a certain fluid, which also gives off a gas; while there is, further, a supply of oxygen and hydrogen inside the cylinder. The cylinder rests on a plate, and by the setting into motion of a small electric motor situated on the right-hand of the gun the gases are exploded, and the projectile is propelled thru the muzzle. There is no recoil, and there is no pressure on the oufside of the cylinder. All pressure is felt forward.
