Unfinished business being now in order, it was moved by Rev. F. H. Almon, and seconded by Rev. J. H. Talbot,—

That this Synod appoint a Committee for the purpose of organizing, as soon as possible, a Diocesan Church of England Temperance Society, and that the Presidents of the Church of England Temperance Societies, being Clergymen of the Church of England, shall be members of this Committee, and such other members as the Synod may appoint, and that such Committee shall report on the work and progress of the Church of England Temperance Society.

Moved in amendment by Mr. Geo. A. Schofield, seconded by Rev. Canon Medley,—

Whereas there is much diversity of opinion as to the working of Church of England Temperance Societies in the Diocese, therefore *Resolved*, That it is not at present desirable to establish any further organization of the kind.

Moved in amendment to the amendment, by Rev. Canon Brigstocke, seconded by Rev. L. A. Hoyt,—

That in the absence of the Bishop it is unadvisable to appoint a Committee for the purpose of organizing a Diocesan Church of England Temperance Society.

Mr. G. A. Schofield, by permission, withdrew his amendment. The Rev. Canon Brigstocke's amendment being then put, was *Carried on a division*, Yeas 54, Nays 40.

Moved by Rev. Canon Brigstocke, seconded by Rev. Stanley Boyd, "Whereas it is very desirable that there should be a Theological College wherein candidates for the Ministry in this Diocese may be duly trained, and whereas such an institution is to be found in King's College, Windsor, and is immediately available for that purpose,
