pressions respecting the Princess not at all dreaming that letters containing those expressions were even in existence, and much less that they could ever be produced, she had denied having any such expressions. When the letters were produced she admitted the expression, but explained them to have been meant merely as equivoques, or double entendres; and in this too she and Sacchi resembled each other; both had their double entendres on this subject; she in her letters to her sister, and he, in his conversation with M. Marietti. In a subsequent part of her testimony her facility in acknowledging what she could no longer concest, that she had made two contradictory statements, and that one was of course inconsistent with the truth, had called forth the warnest culogiam on her credibility. She had been asked. "Did you any that you were in want of money?"—Yes."—"And were you in want of money?"—Yes."—"No!?"—So that in point of fact, and from her own shewing, there was not the smallest concession, in rerum natura, between a thing heing true, and her saying it. And yet so little praise had been bestowed upon her for her admission in this part of her evidence, and that by a person of no common sagacity—he meant shis Learned Friend the Solicitors General. But for his own part he could hardly hare ventured upon such a strain of address even to a man so far degraded below that level of the meanest capacity, as to be only fit for turning out into the fields the

How then could be ever have been prevailed upon to address any man of common sense in language such as this: "Arue, she has on a former occasion told lies; but then see the caudour and ingenuousness with which she acknowledges it, in answer to the questions which you have put to her." He should not, indeed, have felt much surprise after this, at any person of weaker judgment and romantic feeling exclaiming. "Poor ingenious little Sheperdess of the mountains of Switzerland, how innocent a liar thou art!" But when he heard it gravely put, and strongly urged to persons sitting as judges in a case, to believe any thing that was said by a person whom they must know to be a liar from his own showing, and that on the ground of the ingenuousness of that person's acknowledgment of the falsebood of what he had before stated, he could not help exclaiming, that so monstrous, so unheard of a proposition, far out an all that he had ever conceived of what was absurd and extravagant. But the equivoques which she had wished them to believe she had designed as such, were intensy inconsistent in themselves and with each other; and as to the cypher by which they were to be explained, nothing of the kind could she shew in the letters when called on to do so, and her not shewing it proved it never to have existed.
