RECENT DEATHS

Digby, Oct. 9.—Albert J. S. Copp, ex-M. P., died at his home in Digby yesterday after a lingering illness, aged fifty-four years. He is survived by a widow and two daughters, Ethel and Kate, all of whom are at home. He also leaves one brother, T. J. Copp, of Amherst, and one sister, Mrs. T. E. Shipley, of River Heights, Cumberland county.

Mr. Copp was educated at Amherst Academy and also at Dorchester and Acadia (N. B.). He was called to the Nova Scotia bar in 1879. In 1880 he moved to Digby, where for years he carried on a successful practice and was appointed crown prosecutor for Digby county in 1887. In 1880 he married Eliza, youngest daughter of the late Jas. A. Denison, of this town. He was a successful lawyer up to the time he entered politics, when he discontinued his practice.

Mr. Copp was a namesake of Sir Albert James Smith, minister of marine and fisheries during Alex. MacKenzie's administration. He was always an enthusiastic Liberal in politics. In 1886 he was elected representative for Digby county at Ottawa. He was again elected in 1890 and 1894. In 1898 he was defeated by Charles Jameson, Digby's present M. P.

The funeral will take place at 2 p. m. tomorrow at St. John's church, where the late deceased was a communicant. Interment in the Episcopal cemetery.
