The victim was beaten with bamboo rods for two hours in the afternoon, the flesh on his back, arms and legs being form to ribbons. After life had apparently become extinct the executioners, fearing that Chien had marely fainted and might revive, whisted a rope tightly around his neck and left the body in this condition until yesterday morning. Despite the precautions taken by the officials, the prisoner smuggled from his cell a farewell message in the form of a poem in which he glorited reform and exhorted his colleagues to continue the work.
