REGULATIONS For Salting Scotch Pack Herring

One barrel salt to five and a half barrels herring-Large Fulls One barrel salt to six barrels herring-Medium Fulls. One barrel salt to six and a half barrels herring-Matt Fulls. This amount of salt is for dredging and laying on rows only. It

does not take into account that put on the herring before gibbing. All salt falling off herring in rousing tubs is put on rows as you pack unless very dirty of scaly; in that case, you have to make good the same amount, or otherwise you could not have any fixed
