fixed at \$200,000, and is to be paid into the
hands of the Danish Agent in London, when
that ceremony has been performed, the
former treaty of Amity, and navigation
which has been suspended by Act of United
States will return into force.

A Telegram from Hamburg says the
Danish Cabinet received an account of the
attitude of Denmark in the dispute with
Germany.

Sweden.—A partial modification of
Swedish Cabinet is anticipated.

London, Saturday Morning.—
The Times City article says the funds
opened Friday morning at a decline of one
eighth, and subsequently experienced a further
fall, owing to speculative sales, consequent
upon the unsettled state of feeling in Paris,
likely to be increased by the trial of the
cooperators. Applications for discount at
the Bank are very slightly increased,
but continued very moderate.

The Daily News City article says the
Stock Market on Friday was weaker.
The funds after sustaining an extreme
reaction of one half per cent., closed at 3-5ths
per cent., lower than Thursday. The mar-
ket is to an unusual extent influenced by
the Paris Bourse, which exhibits a gradual
decline.

Mr. D. Israel
has sought his address to the electors
of Bucks, offering himself as a candidate
for re-election. The following passage occurs
in his address:—"The circumstances of the
country are in my respects critical, and in
none more so than in its external relations.
Painful misconceptions have risen with the
government of that faithful and powerful
ally, who in many instances has proved his
good feeling and fidelity to this country.
Believing that a cordial alliance between
England and France is equally consistent
to the interest of both countries, I shall
express my hope and conviction that by
measures at one firm and conciliatory, these
causes of misunderstanding may be speedily
and entirely removed. If the country
will heartily support the Queen's Govern-
ment at its disposal, the result on a desirable
for the peace and progress of Europe will
be greatly facilitated."

Sir J. Mackintosh addresses the electors
of Droiwick. No opposition is expected.
After announcing that he has joined Lord
Derby's Cabinet, he says:—"It is essential
to the well working of our system of Par-
liamentary Government that people should
not suppose that it is only one man who
can be entrusted with public interests."
The China mail of yesterday has brought
correct statistics of the tea trade for the
past year. The total exports were £25,700,000
against £24,400,000 last year; and £24,1-
800,000 at the same period of 1856.

It is remarked in the daily News City
article, that with the present rates of ex-
change with the chief centre of European
commerce, for the largest proportion of
gold imported here will be sent to the coun-
try as fast as it comes in; but it does
not imply that the stock of bullion in the
Bank has yet reached its highest point.
Advance from Calcutta are all respects
satisfactory. Government securities had
risen 4 to 5 per cent., and although 5 per
cent. discount, confidence amongst native
holders was evidently reviving.

We understand that Kennedy who was
last summer, convicted of Murder, at Wind-
sor, and whose case was recently brought
before a full bench of Judges in Halifax,
and recommended to the merciful consid-
eration of the Executive authorities, has re-
ceived a conditional pardon. The Execu-
tive have commuted the death penalty for
that of two years imprisonment in the Pro-
vincial Penitentiary, the commencement of
the two years to be computed from the time
when Kennedy was first imprisoned in
Windsor.—Huller Paper.
