**BENZYL MORPHINE.**—Benzylmorphine,  $C_{17}H_{18}NO_2 \cdot O.C_2H_5C_6$ , is formed by the action of benzyl chloride on morphine in the presence of

an alkali and a diluent such as alcohol. It crystallises in large prisms, which are readily soluble in alcohol, ether, benzene, etc., but it does not give the blue color reaction with ferric chloride peculiar to morphine. The preparation is said to have various advantages over codeine, as a substitute for which it is largely employed.—*Pharm. Zeit.*, xlii., 448.

**GLYCERIC ETHER.**—Stochr obtains glyceric ether by distilling glycerin with phosphoric acid. The product  $C_6H_{10}O_3$ , which results from the condensation of two molecules of the alcohol, crystallises from ether in shining tablets or in prisms, which melt at  $124^\circ$  to  $125^\circ C.$  and boil at  $209^\circ C.$  without decomposing. The glyceric ether is removed from an aqueous solution by mercuric chloride with which it forms a crystalline compound.—*Pharm. Centralb.*, xxxviii, 441.

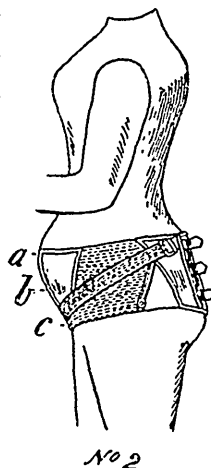
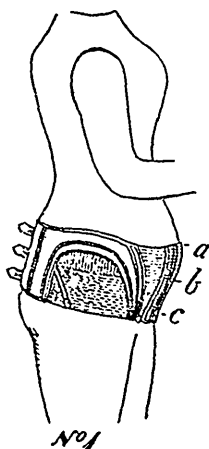
