Of *George Pouliot* and of *Helene Fiset* wife of the late *George Boissonault*, praying for indemnity for their means of support, being removed by the Senate.

Of *John Tytler* and others of the Township of *Clarence*, County of *Russell*; of *Martin Casselman* and others of the Township of *Cambridge*, County of *Russell*; of *John Dew* and others, of the Township of *Osgoode*, in the said County of *Russell*; of *John Hale* and others, of the Village of *New Glasgow*, County of *Terrebonne*; of *Pierre Desjardins* and others, of *Ste. Thérèse de Blainville*, County of *Terrebonne*; and of *A. Dumas* and others, of the Town of *Terrebonne*, severally praying that the House will take such measures as to cause the obstructions to the navigation of the *Ottawa River* to be removed, and an uninterrupted line to the full capacity of the leading channel and the supply of water from the summit level to be opened throughout.

Of *J. Metcalfe* and others, of the Province of *Ontario*, praying that certain facilities may be granted to the *Huron and Ontario Ship Canal Company* to enable them to carry out the objects of their Charter.
