

right to dower became consummate by the death of the husband before the eighteenth day of May, which was in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one.

right to dower became consummate before 18th May, 1861.

13. In all cases not otherwise provided for by this Act, the pleadings and proceedings shall be regulated by the law as it was in force in Upper Canada, relative to suits and actions of dower, before the tenth day of August, which was in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

Made of proceedings where not prescribed

14. This Act shall apply to Upper Canada only.

To apply to U. C. only.

15. This Act may be cited as *The Dower Act of Upper Canada*.
