C A P. CXXXV.

An Act to alter the Conditions and Regulations under which Blubber and Train Oil of Newfoundland are admitted to Entry. [4th July 1815.]

THEREAS it is expedient that the Conditions and Regulations contained in an Act, passed in the Forty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled An Act for repealing the 49 G.s. c.98. feveral Duties of Customs chargeable in Great Britain, and for granting other Duties in lieu thereof, under which Blubber and Train Oil, the Produce of Fish or Creatures living in the Sea, taken and caught on the Banks and Shores of Newfoundland, and Parts adjacent, by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on fuch Fishery from that Island, were to be admitted to Entry as fuch, should be altered; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affem-bled, and by the Authority of the fame, That from and after the Tenth Conditions Day of October One thousand eight hundred and fifteen, before any Blubber under which and Train Oil imported into Great Britain, as being taken and caught on Blubber and Train Oil of Name of Name and Parts adjacent wholly by the Banks and Shores of Newfoundland, and Parts adjacent, wholly by Newfound-His Majesty's Subjects carrying on fuch Fishery from that Island, shall be land shall be admitted to Entry on Payment of the Duty imposed on fuch Blubber or admitted to Train Oil by the faid recited Act, the Master or other Person having or Entry. taking the Charge or Command of the Ship or Veffel in which the fame shall be imported shall produce and deliver to the Collector or other Chief Officer of the Cultoms at the Port of Importation, a Certificate under the Hand and Seal of the Governor or Deputy Governor of Newfoundland, or 13 X of
