C A P. CXXXV.

An Act to alter the Conditions and Regulations under which Blubber and Train Oil of *Newfoundland* are admitted to Entry. [4th July 1815.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Conditions and Regulations contained in an Act, passed in the Forty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled *An Act for repealing the several Duties of Customs chargeable in Great Britain, and for granting other Duties in lieu thereof*, under which Blubber and Train Oil, the Produce of Fish or Creatures living in the Sea, taken and caught on the Banks and Shores of *Newfoundland*, and Parts adjacent, by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on such Fishery from that Island, were to be admitted to Entry as such, should be altered; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the Tenth Day of *October* One thousand eight hundred and fifteen, before any Blubber and Train Oil imported into *Great Britain*, as being taken and caught on the Banks and Shores of *Newfoundland*, and Parts adjacent, wholly by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on such Fishery from that Island, shall be admitted to Entry on Payment of the Duty imposed on such Blubber or Train Oil by the said recited Act, the Master or other Person having or taking the Charge or Command of the Ship or Vessel in which the same shall be imported shall produce and deliver to the Collector or other Chief Officer of the Customs at the Port of Importation, a Certificate under the Hand and Seal of the Governor or Deputy Governor of *Newfoundland*, or
