

BRITISH PREFERENTIAL DUTIES
ON WOOLLEN AND KNIT GOODS AFFECTED BY
BUDGET ; MAY 11TH, 1923.

557 Yarns woollen & worsted, n.o.p.	20%	2%	18%
565 Blankets	22½%	2½%	20¼%
566 Flannels, plain, lustres, etc.	20%	2%	18%
567 Clothing, cloths, tweeds, etc.	27½%	2¾%	24¾%
568 Undershirts, drawers, knitted goods	20%	2%	18%
568a Socks and stockings, all kinds	25%	2½%	22½%
572 Carpets and rugs	25%	2½%	22½%

Note: In June 1922 the British Preference on Items 566, 567, and 568 was increased by 2½%, making the reduction in duties in a period of one year:
