hundred and fifty years she has been a British country, scarcely less amazing has been the growth and expansion of the British Empire within that period of time. It will be recalled that at the time Welfe was bringing glory to British arms in Canada, Clive was laying the Soundations of future British greatness in India. The Seven Years War (1756-63) was the real beginning of the British Empire. At that time little was known of Australia, New Zealand or South Africa. A century later the two former were state British colonies, the latter had still to become a British community. To-day all three are self-governing Dominions of the British Commonwealth of Nations, and, like Canada, as we have just been told by the Prime Minister of Great Britain and the heir to the British throne, equal in status with the other self-governing parts of the British Empire.
