

The licence issued by Mr Savage
 in this case was properly issued.
 As soon as a lot covered by an
 Indian licence has been sold for
 settlement the holder of the licence
 ceases to have any right to the timber
 on the lots sold with the exception
 of pine, which latter the licensee is
 entitled to cut for 3 years from
 date of sale. As no pine has been
 cut with the permission of this
 Dept on your limit and as what
 cedar has been cut thereon was cut
 under the authority of the then
 authorized agent of this Dept, who
 did not exceed his duty in
 giving such authority, I have
 to inform you your claim for
 \$1000 in connection with
 your limit cannot be
 entertained.
