
Ottawa, May 17, 1911.

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your Application dated 4th instant in behalf of the Burrard Inlet Tunnel and Bridge Co., to purchase a tract containing about 49.00 acres in the Seymour Creek Indian reserve, No. 2, of the Squamish Band of Indians, B.C. and of the provisional agreement made with six Indians residing on the reserve.

I have to inform you that an application has been before the Department for some time from the Vancouver, Westminster and Yukon Railway Co., for the Right of Way through the said reserve as shown on the blue print plan enclosed herewith which you will note is through the tract applied for by yourself. I have to request you to be good enough to state whether your application holds good for the piece of land in question excepting thereout the strip applied for by the said Railway Company.
