

CHRONIC BRONCHITIS.

Bronchitis is an inflammation of the mucous membrane of the bronchial tubes, and is one of the most common of the pulmonary affections. Chronic bronchitis more often occurs later in life. In the latter stage of the disease, the mucous membrane of the larger bronchial tube softens, while in the smaller tubes and air cells of the lungs the mucous membrane becomes congested and inflamed. There are no cavities or tubercles in the lungs, but merely a watery sticky place from the obstruction of the bronchial tubes and the accumulation of mucus. The patient dies from exhaustion and suffocation, being unable to expectorate the mucus which accumulates in the passages leading to the lungs, which in some cases is sticky and small in quantity, but more commonly copious, of a light straw or yellowish green. Sometimes streaks of blood make their appearance in the mucus, and at times there is a disagreeable smell. Persons thus afflicted are very liable to take a cold, at which time the mucus becomes clear and frothy, and it is not uncommonly the case that the patient dies in one of those attacks.
