

CABLE RATE CONTROL GOOD FOR ALL PARTIES

Both Public and Companies To Be Benefited by Proposed Government Act.

Ottawa, April 26.—Postmaster-General Lemieux was before the Senate today committee today in connection with his bill to place cable companies under the control of the Dominion Railway Commission.

The minister said that he was quite convinced of the practicability of the plan to control cable rates provided by the bill. It would operate to the benefit of the cable companies, as well as the public. Canada alone could not control cable rates, but he thought that Canada and Great Britain acting together could do so, as these are the most important cables in the world and terminate in Great Britain and this country.

Mr. Lemieux announced that he had assurances from Hon. Mr. Buxton, postmaster-general of Great Britain, that a bill similar to that of Canada's would be brought down in the course of a short time in the Imperial House. With the additional amendment suggested, he thought the bill would pass.

Mr. Lemieux explained that it was proposed to have messages divided into two classes, urgent and deferred. The latter to be handled at a lower rate when the cables were not crowded.

The idea of the British authorities was that a fair schedule would be for urgent messages a snail's pace, and for deferred sixpence per word, and for press messages threepence per word.

Mr. S. S. Dickson, vice-president of the Commercial Cable Company, denied that there were any idle hours on the cable lines. He did not think the deferred plan would work. As a matter of fact it had been tried and abandoned.

The bill was passed with amendments specifying that the Canadian act would depend on the passage of Imperial legislation.

ENORMOUS INCREASE IN CANADA'S TRADE

Over Six Hundred and Seventy-Seven Millions for the Fiscal Year.

Ottawa, April 26.—Canada's total trade for the fiscal year ending last month, reached the record figure of \$777,142,189. This is an increase of no less than \$117,596,238, or over twenty per cent, as compared with the preceding twelve months. It is an increase of over twenty-six millions as compared with the previous high record of 1907-8.

At present the regular monthly increases over the corresponding months of last year are running over ten millions per month, and indications point to a total trade in the neighborhood of eight hundred millions for the current fiscal year.

The total imports for the year were \$375,782,660, an increase of \$77,659,868 over 1908-9. Exports of domestic products totalled \$275,211,257, an increase of \$12,667,921.

Exports of foreign products totalled \$22,148,992, an increase of \$3,228,419. The chief items of export for the year with comparative figures, are as follows:

They will not admit running down the victim. Dionne's car was the only one on the bridge that night and both lamps are broken.

The coroner's jury, which inquired into the death of Bessie Smith, struck by the automobile on Victoria Bridge Sunday night, found J. L. Keifer, the chauffeur, and L. A. Dionne, the owner, criminally responsible for her death. The jury recommended that the Grand Trunk should build a foot-path on the bridge as well as illuminate it.

Kelly walked the entire distance from Brandon and encountered terrible hardships on the way.

SHACKLETON MAY SETTLE IN CANADA

Famous Explorer Would Like to Penetrate and Open Up the Wilds.

Toronto, April 27.—A strong inclination to settle in Canada and engage in exploration of the great stretches of land in the north and northwest possesses Sir Ernest H. Shackleton, the famous explorer of the Antarctic. Sir Ernest Shackleton arrived in the city yesterday, and is the guest of Mr. Byron E. Walker, at 99 St. George street. Sir Ernest expressed his desire, as soon as he gets through his present affairs in connection with the expedition on which he reached a point 97 geographical miles from the South Pole, to come and settle down in this country, where, he says, there are great things for a man to do in 25 years.

His idea is to organize a corps of trained mineralogists and prospectors, men who are accustomed to rough work, but at the same time experienced in scientific exploration, to carry on a series of rapid surveys. In these they would discover the real value of the different regions of the Dominion, which are still scarcely scratched.

There is little prospect of any decrease in the price of beef in London. The most potent cause of the existing high prices is the scarcity of good beef cattle. This was the cause given by a number of butchers in speaking to The Advertiser this morning.

"A day's trip through the surrounding country would be enough to satisfy the most doubting one as to the scarcity of beef," said a well-known local wholesale butcher to The Advertiser this morning.

Effect of English Prices. "A great many butchers attribute the high figure to the price of Canadian beef on the English market," he continued. "Canadian beef is quoted at \$14.50 to \$15.25 a hundredweight on the English market. Of course, this has something to do with it, but after all there is not much difference in the price when all expenses are totalled up. Moreover, when beef carcasses are shipped to the old country the offal must be thrown in. This includes hide and tallow, and cuts quite a considerable figure in the price.

Beef cattle are scarce in Ontario, Manitoba, and, in fact, all over Canada, and until this scarcity abates, Canadians cannot hope for cheaper beef.
