CORONER'S JURY FAILS TO FIX RESPONSIBILITY

Indiana, Pa., Feb. 3.—A coroner's jury yesterday failed to fix responsibility for the death of 36 miners in an explosion at the Lancashire mine of Lancashire Coal Company at Shaktown, January 26, last. A verdict was returned finding that the miners had been killed by an explosion of gas, but "that the exact cause of the explosion was not known."
