A musical toy on the same principle as the symphonion is sold by Hickson, Duncan & Co., to retail at \$1.50.

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Children's wagons, wheelbarrows, and doll's carriages are a line that trade has opened briskly in with H. A. Nelson & Sons.

The dolls in the spring samples show an advance on the make of a year ago. They will also be cheaper. Window dolls are finer and cheaper.

The musical skipping rope will this year be cheaper than it was a year ago, the time of its patenting and introduction. It is now simplified and got up at less cost, while the demand has lowered the price. It will sell now at 10c. not as a year ago at 25c.

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Caution!—There have recently been issued several cheap reprints of the 1867 edition of Webster's Unabridged Dictionary, an edition long since superannuated. These books are given various names,—"Webster's Unabridged," "The Great Webster's Dictionary," "Webster's Big Dictionary," "Webster's Encyclopedic Dictionary," etc., etc.

Many announcements concerning them are very misleading, as the body of each, from A to Z, is 44 years old, and printed from cheap plates made by photographing the old pages.

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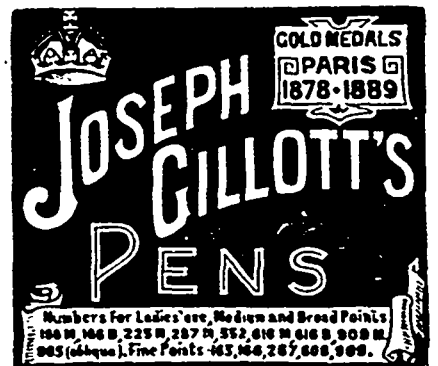
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
