

General Strike in Porcupine Does Not Affect the Market

BEARS HELD CONTROL AGAIN IN CHICAGO WHEAT MARKET

Rapidly Increasing Supplies and the Lack of Adequate Demand Carried Prices Down Into New Low Ground—Corn Also On Down Grade.

CHICAGO, Nov. 18.—Rapidly increasing supplies and no adequate demand allowed the bears to remain in control. The close was weak, 5-8c to 3-4c under last night. Corn finished 1-4c to 3-8c lower, oats varying from a shade off to a like amount up, and provisions unchanged to an advance of 2-4c.

Except for an unfounded report that peace negotiations had been broken off, bulls in wheat found no encouragement of even a temporary sort. The effect in the pit, however, proved brief and selling was general and free. Argentine weather was favorable, northwestern corn arrivals for the week nearly double those of a year ago, and Chicago receipts 1,500,000 bushels in excess of the shipments. Moreover, the Russian spring crop was reported to be 50 per cent. larger than in 1911.

Ideal weather brought the corn market to the lowest level of the year. Despite weak and evening up little power to recuperate was shown.

Oats developed comparative strength. Offerings were light and contract stocks small.

Provisions ruled firmer, owing to a large shrinkage in the amount of land on hand. At the end of the daylard had risen 15c to 20c.

ST. LAWRENCE MARKET.

Receipts of farm produce were 500 bushels of grain, 6 loads of hay and about 40 loads of other produce in the morning building, all of the available space left being taken by the farmers and market gardeners.

Grain—Five hundred bushels of wheat, oats and barley sold at 11c to 11 1/2c. Potatoes—Potatoes by the single bag sold at from 81c to 81 1/2c, delivered.

Butter—The market for butter was easy at unchanged quotations, ranging from 25c to 30c, but few got 25c, the bulk selling at 26c to 28c and 30c.

Eggs—New-laid eggs were scarce, selling at 50c to 55c, and we heard of one farmer getting 55c, the bulk sold at 50c to 52c.

The Mono Poultry Company sold their eggs, every egg dated upon the day it was laid, at 10c per dozen. This company sold about 125 dozen, and their eggs are just what they represent—strictly new-laid and of fine quality. True, many of them are of small size, but they are certainly delicious when you taste them. The company is supplying a long-felt want on this market.

Poultry—Receipts were large and generally of good quality. Turkeys sold at 25c to 30c per lb.; geese, 15c to 18c; ducks, 12c to 15c, with a very few of select quality at 15c and 20c per lb.; chickens, 10c to 12c per lb.; fowls, 10c to 12c.

M. P. Mallon reports receipts of poultry, both dead and alive, as being large, but not greater than those of the previous week, as usual, had a busy week, handling many tons of the dressed article. Prices have remained steady at quotations given in table.

The general strike in the Porcupine camp, on the 11th, did not pose as a factor of any importance to the mining exchanges on Saturday. It was freely stated that the men were not well organized and that there was no prospect of work being interrupted for any length of time. In consequence, speculators were not inclined to view the matter as at all critical, and practically ignored it as a market influence.

Trading continued on the same narrow plane that has characterized the movement of late. None of the usual favorite came in for any particular attention, while the extremely narrow price changes bore evidence to the failure of the list to develop any definite tendency.

The market generally was lower, cargoes more freely offered from the fact that Russian steamers at Gibraltar are pressed for sale. Canadian offerings are liberal and rather pressed for sale and expectations are for liberal world's shipments this week. Just before the close there was some covering by shorts and part of the decline was recovered on and part of the market was steady, 1/4c to 1/2c lower than yesterday.
