LEADERS OF FINANCE
PAY HIGH HONOR TO
BRITISH COMMISSION

Chamber of Commerce Entertains Balfour Party.

New York, May 12.—America's most distinguished leaders of industry, commerce and finance have paid high honor to Arthur J. Balfour, British secretary of state for foreign affairs, and member of the war mission visiting this city, at a reception and luncheon at the chamber of commerce. It was perhaps the most notable gathering of its kind that has ever taken place in this city, and the guests included many of the most prominent names in the nation's metropolis.

The historical importance of the event was interpreted by H. O. Outbridge, president of the chamber, when in bidding welcome to the former British prime minister and his associates, he said: "This chamber, now entering its fifth year of its existence, has received its original charter in 1912 from King George III, has ever participated in the most important events of which, social or political, commerce must go hand in hand."
