Toronto—Daily with Grand Trunk, Credit Valley, Midland, Toronto, Grey and Bruce, and Canadian Pacific Rys.

Hamilton—Direct connection with Grand Trunk and Hamilton and Dundas Railways.

STEAMBOAT CONNECTIONS.

During Season of Navigation.

Toronto—Daily with Royal Mail Line Steamers for Kingston, Montreal and Quebec; Steamer "Chicora" for Niagara and Lewiston, and "Empress of India" for Port Dalhousie.

Muskoka Wharf—Steamers "Nipissing" and "Kenozha" in close connection with trains, twice daily to Bracebridge, and daily to Port Carling, Widemere and Rosseau. Also daily during the tourists' season to Port Cockburn, Port Sanfield and Ports on Lake Joseph. Semi-weekly (Mondays and Fridays) to last named points during spring and fall. Tri-weekly (Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays) to Bala.

Bracebridge—Stages daily for Port Sidney; thence Steamer "Northern" for Huntsville, Hoodstown, and intermediate places. Daily for Baysville; thence Steamers "Mary Louise" and "Excelsior" for Dwight, Dorset and other places on the Lake of Bays and Trading Lake.

Rosseau—Stage daily for Ashdown, Trout Lake, Falding, Featherston, Parry Harbour and Parry Sound, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, for Seguin Falls, Magnetawan and Lake Nipissing; and thence new Steamer "Inter Ocean" to points on Lake Nipissing. From Magnetawan steamer "Pioneer" makes trips to Burk's Falls.

Collingwood—Collingwood Line—Lake Superior Steamer "Campana" is expected to sail from Collingwood at 2.00 p.m., on following dates:—July 3rd, 14th and 24th; August 4th, 14th and 25th, for Sault Ste.
