THE LUSITANIA

Incidents of Sinking of Great Steamer Show High Qualities of Heroism Among Passengers, Officers and Crew

London, May 9.—The total list of survivors up to midnight from the ill-fated Lusitania was 764, including 462 passengers and 802 crew. The dead and unaccounted for aggregate 1,208. Survivors say that the crew adhered to disciplinary instructions and did all possible to aid the passengers, especially the women and children, to safety.
